In the event of injury to a horse or rider after the games commence, the remaining 4 riders will take part in the remaining games.

Clubs may field only one EXHIBITION games team, consisting of Associate rider's over 17 years. The Associate rider that participates in the junior CHAMPIONSHIP team may also ride in the Associate Exhibition team, however not on the same mount.

Dressage Competition Rules

- One rider per horse.
- Only 2010/2011 Graded combinations may compete in the Dressage Competition. (PCANT Dressage Grading [Blue card](#))
- A maximum of 2 consecutive levels can be entered.
- A maximum of 3 tests can be ridden per day providing there is enough time; riders need to consider which test they will drop if there are time constraints.
- A groom mounted in a saddle and wearing an approved safety helmet and boots may walk the horse on a long rein only.
- Groom and or handler must be a financial member of an NT Pony Club.
- Lunging and work in-hand by someone other than the nominated rider is permitted.
- Refer to the Equestrian Australia Dressage Rules and Regulations for further information.

Show Jumping Competition Rules and Regulations

PCANT Show Jumping Champs are run under EA/FEI standards of Jumping and the PCANT Handbook.

Only 2010 /2011 Graded combinations (PCANT Show Jumping Grading **Orange card**) may compete in the Show Jumping Competition.

Events 1- 5 Table A Competition

This event will be judged under Article 238.1.2.

A competition not against the clock with a time allowed but in the event of equality of penalties for first place there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other athletes are placed according to their penalties in the first round.

Events 6- 10 Two Round Competition

This event will be judged under Articles 273.1, 273.2, 273.2.2, 273.3.2 and 274.4.1.

This competition consists of two courses of the same speed.

The first and second round is not against the clock.

The second round course is identical or different in track or in the number of obstacles or in the dimensions of the obstacles.

Each competitor must participate in both rounds on the same horse.

Competitors that have been eliminated or retired during the first round may not take part in the second round.

A limited number of riders go forward into the second round in reverse order of penalties.

Numbers to be determined by the judge (at least a minimum of 25% of eligible riders)

In the event of riders being on equal penalties, a jump off will be conducted.

Competitors will be placed according to the penalties and time in the jump off. The remaining competitors will be placed according to aggregate penalties over both rounds and the time incurred in the first round.

Events 11- 15 Accumulator Competition

This event will be judged under Article 269

This competition takes place over 6, 8 or 10 obstacles with an increasing difficulty.

Combination obstacles are not allowed. The increasing difficulty is not solely due to the height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track.© 2009

Bonus points are awarded as follows: 1 point for obstacle No 1, 2 points for No 2, 3 points for No 3, etc. with a total of 21,36 or 55 points. No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Faults other than knock-downs are penalised as for Table A.

This competition may take place either with the first round against the clock and a jump-off in case of equality of penalties for the first place following the initial round or not against the clock with a jump-off or directly against the clock. In case of a jump-off there will be a minimum of six obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread. The obstacles in the jump-off must be jumped in the same order as in the first round and retain their respective points allotted in the first round.

If the competition takes place not against the clock with a jump-off, An athlete not qualified for the jump-off, are placed according to their points obtained in the first round, disregarding the time. If the competition has taken place with the first round against the clock and jump-off, an athlete that has not qualified for the jump-off will be placed according to penalties and time obtained in the first round.

For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one element may be designated the Joker. The Joker must be more difficult than the alternative obstacle and carry double points. If the Joker is knocked down, these points must be deducted from the total points obtained so far by the athlete.

Scoring

Each event will hold equal weighting of points for determining Champion Show Jumper in each grade and Champion team. In the event of a tie, the highest win or place in the Two Round Competition will be used to determine the outcome.

Points for individual competitions will be awarded according to the exact placing in each class. Team points will be awarded according to the placing of the team competitors in the event. The best 4 scores in each event for the team will count towards the team score.

Arena boundary

An arena boundary will be established marking the boundary of the show jump arena. As per Article 240.3.17, 240.3.18, 240.3.19, 240.4.1 and 240.4.2 riders will be eliminated for leaving the arena following the ringing of the bell and prior to the completion of the course.

Practice fences

Only the next three horses in the draw may use the practice area/practice fences at one time. Practice fences are not to exceed the height of the fences in the competition.

Sideline coaching during competition

Sideline coaching including any verbal assistance provided to competitors whilst they are in the arena may result in the elimination of the competitor by the judge. This does not include standard crowd cheering.

Walking the course

Team members must be in the correct attire to walk the course.

Only those members actually competing and the Team Manager are allowed to walk the course.

The time allowed to walk the course will not exceed 20 minutes

Trophy

1. The NT Pony Club Championships are conducted under the rules and guidelines of the PCANT Handbook. Please familiarise yourselves with the required attire, gear, tack, age of riders on your team, etc. The handbook can be accessed through your club secretary or online at www.ponyclubnt.org.au
2. Mount eligibility – for this competition, one mount may only have one rider per discipline. If a mount is to be ridden by another rider in a different discipline on the same day, please make this clear on your nomination form.
3. Rider eligibility - the riders must have attended 50% of rallies in accordance with Section 2.04 of the PCANT handbook.
4. A rider may have multiple mounts, but may ride only one mount in each team.
5. Substitution of Horse and Rider – in the event of any illness or injury, particularly with competitors travelling from other parts of the Territory, a horse and / or rider may be substituted in a team with 24 hours written notice before the commencement of the competition, submitted to the Chief Steward.
6. Age of rider applies as at the 01.01.2011
7. ASSOCIATE GAMES “Exhibition Games Team 2011” – to consist of 5 pony club riders 17 years & over. Only one of these five riders may compete in the club games team that will vie for the mounted games championship trophy.
8. All nominations close on Monday 30th May 2011 and must be accompanied by a nomination fee and a payment reference record – no late entries will be accepted.
9. The Disputes will be made up of the Chief Steward and Presidents from each club (or their nominated delegate). All disputes must be lodged in writing to the Disputes Committee within 30 minutes of the alleged infringements accompanied by a non-refundable \$50 fee.
10. Camping is by arrangement with Darwin Horse and Pony Club, who will assist with the designating of areas for horses and campers. Please contact Darwin Horse and Pony Club President

General Rules & Regulations

11. Presentations will be awarded after the end of each of the disciplines with the presentation of Champion Pony Club to occur after the Show Jumping Presentations. Riders are requested to be in uniform for all presentations and mounted if possible.
12. There will be designated warm up areas and all riders are asked to keep to that area for warming up. Riders must walk their horses at all times other than in the warm up area or the main arena.
13. All riders must be gear checked before competing. Any alteration to tack must be represented for gear check.
14. All riders under 17 years of age must have a designated adult guardian. The active participation and help of parents and guardians is most appreciated and strongly encouraged for the smooth running and enjoyment of the event.
15. Only four riders are required to warm up in the main arena before their class in Dressage and only three riders for the Jumping events. Stewards will assist riders standing by for their event, to proceed to the main arena when required.
16. Each team nominating for the Prince Philip Mounted Games must provide two lane stewards.
17. Only 2010 /2011 Graded combinations may compete in the Show Jumping Competition. (Orange card)
18. Only 2010 /2011 Graded combinations may compete in the Dressage Competition. (Blue card)
19. Current Grading Cards must be presented to the "Officials Desk"; it is an individual rider's responsibility and the Team Manager's responsibility to hand in their competitor's cards prior to jumping/dressage. (no card no ride)
20. Stables are covered and there are taps and hoses available for water. There are only limited stables which will be allocated on a 'first in' basis. All stables must be mucked out prior to leaving. Stabled horses will at all times remain the responsibility of the owner.

21. As a safety precaution any falls that incur a knock to the head (helmet) will require the rider to replace the helmet with a different one of a safe standard before continuing to ride.
22. Pam Crellin Memorial Award for Pony Club Dressage, Which will become a perpetual tribute to Pam who lost her battle with leukemia last October 2010. Pam was a highly successful rider and a valued instructor who was a major contributor to the dressage community - especially to pony club. PCANT wishes to celebrate Pam's equestrian endeavors and recognize her significant contributions to the dressage world with an award for correct training principals, which epitomizes Pam's approach to dressage. **This Pony Club Dressage Award is presented to a rider who shows a passion for dressage through participation and who in the eyes of the judges has tried to establish a sound training scale through correct dressage principals that will enable them to progress in the equestrian discipline of Dressage.**
