### **DEVELOPMENT SQUAD EVENTS**

This is a general outline of the events we hope to hold through the year. Please note that some of these may change or be omitted.

Events we are planning through the year:

- Early flatwork and grid work training through out pony club season. Early theoretical sessions on fitness, feeding, conditioning, tack & other equipment to set you up ready for the start of the show season.
- Continued mounted sessions through the year (although not as regularly due to restrictions in time). Continued theoretical sessions to discuss the rules of competition, officiating, & travelling horses, as well as critiquing your competition performances with coaches and peers.
- Video recording of your riding for personal critiquing. This may be shared with the riders in the Southern Region via internet, and may also be critiqued by Darwin-based instructors.
- An intensive development camp. Squad members from all regions will be encouraged to attend this.
- Squad run Pony Club event. Riders will be officials at this event, and so will not ride. This will act both as practical experience and as a fundraising opportunity.
- Fundraising events throughout the year.
- Attendance at Pony Club shows and gymkhanas.
